About Robin Easton:

Robin Easton was twenty-five when she left the United States and went to live with her husband in the remote tropical Daintree Rainforest of Queensland, Australia. This ancient forest transformed Robin's life so completely that she was inspired to write *Naked in Eden*. The Daintree is one of the world's oldest tropical rainforests, home to a vast number of rare and threatened species. While living in Australia, kangaroos, birds and bandicoots befriended Robin as her bare feet shared paths with foot-long centipedes, bird-eating spiders, leeches and ticks. She also learned to handle and identify some of the world's deadliest snakes.

She spent much of her adult life in wild and remote areas, including Australia's tropical and subtropical rainforests, Alaska, and the Maine North Woods. Easton has traveled to New Zealand, Tasmania, Mexico and Canada, and has lived throughout Europe.

One of Robin's most remarkable rainforest experiences was the gift of music. During her last year in the rainforests of Australia she began to dream beautiful music. When she returned to the United States she sat at a piano and played as if she'd played for ten years. Unable to read music, Robin has performed on the east coast, and recorded on both the east and west coasts. She's produced and published her own piano solo album, all from her original dream music.

Robin loves to hike, camp, canoe, kayak, swim and garden. She also enjoys playing the Native American courting flute, composing piano solos, singing, roller-skating, skiing, travel, and time spent laughing and sharing with friends. Easton is not only a writer, but also a glass artisan, potter, musician, and nature photographer.

Driven by her passionate love of the wild, Robin has been involved in helping to protect remote areas like the lowland Daintree Rainforest, the Ruahines of New Zealand, and The Great Bear Rainforest of British Columbia.
